On June 20, 1984, the President's eleventh special message for fiscal year 1984 was submitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message proposes three new deferrals totalling \$1,850,000 and revisions to five previously reported deferrals totalling \$98,533,000. Our report follows.
