To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

This letter reports on the status of budget authority that the President proposed for rescission in the sixth special impoundment message for fiscal year 1993, dated June 4, 1993, but for which the Congress has not passed a rescission bill as defined in section 1011(3) of the Impoundment Control Act (the Act). The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has informed us that the funds proposed for rescission in the sixth message were not withheld from obligation. proposed rescissions are set forth in the enclosed listing submitted by the President with his sixth special message.

Section 1012(b) of the Act requires that funds proposed for rescission be made available for obligation unless the Congress completes action on rescission bills within the 45-day period of continuous congressional session following the day such proposal is received by the Congress. For the rescission proposal submitted in the sixth special message, the 45-day period ended on July 31, 1993, without the Congress having passed such a bill for two of the proposals.1

We have confirmed with OMB that all funds proposed for rescission which Congress did not approve are available for obligation.
