Dear Senator Proxmire:

This is in response to your letter of August 3, 1973, requesting us to investigate the matter of the military services continuing to authorize flight pay to admirals and generals. You asked us to determine whether the military services were attempting to circumvent the intent of Title VII, Section 715, P.L. 92-570. In subsequent discussions with your staff, it was agreed that the report we prepared for Congressman Aspin on this matter would satisfy your request, provided there was concurrent release of the report. In addition, it was agreed that we would provide you a list of the Navy billets occupied by captains and admirals which have been designated operational flying billets.

We requested the Secretary of Defense to furnish us with information on this subject. Enclosure I is a list showing, by military service, the names and duty stations of those admirals and generals who were entitled to receive flight pay since June 1, 1973.

Regarding the services' justification for authorizing flight pay to admirals and generals after May 31, 1973, we have been advised by the Department of Defense officials that the military services took its admirals and generals off of flight pay after May 31, 1973, evaluated the duties required of the incumbents of these positions and issued new lists showing those admiral and general positions which are now authorized to collect flight pay.

This action reduced the number of admiral and general positions authorized to receive flight pay. In each instance, the justification for paying these officers flight pay is based upon their incumbency of "operational flying" positions with duties normally requiring the maintenance of basic flying skills. The services maintain that these positions are not subject to the May 31, 1973, pay-cut-off of Section 715, P.L. 92-570. Instead, they receive pay, if otherwise entitled, under the provisions of Section 301, Title 37, United States Code and Executive Order 11157, as amended.

After reviewing this case, our General Counsel is of the opinion that:

"\*\*\*Section 715 does not preclude the payment of flight pay to rated officers in the grades of 0-6 and above who, under regulations prescribed by the Secretary of Defense, are actually occupying positions which are properly determined to require the maintenance of basic flying skills. If under those regulations, the positions which the admirals and generals in question are occupying are proper, then we see no legal barrier in Section 715 of Public Law 92-570 which would prohibit them from receiving flight pay."

We did not independently determine whether the services had properly classified these positions. Such a determination would have required a case by case review with no assurance that the results would be conclusive.

We are also including as Enclosure II, a list provided us by Navy officials showing, by pay grade and billet description, the number of captain and admiral positions the Navy has designated as operational flying billets.

We trust this information satisfies your request.
