To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On February 1, 1984, the President's sixth special message for fiscal year 1984 was submitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message proposes nine rescissions totalling \$634,711,454, thirteen new deferrals totalling \$143,595,000, and revisions to five previously reported deferrals totalling \$68,152,365. Our report follows.
