To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On March 13, 1996, the President submitted to the Congress his fifth special impoundment message for fiscal year 1996. The message reports five proposed rescissions of budget authority numbers R96-21 through R96-25.¹ We have reviewed the proposed rescissions contained in the fifth special message and found them to be in accordance with the Impoundment Control Act, 2 U.S.C. § 681, et seq., as amended.

Enclosure I provides specific information with regard to the proposed rescissions reported in the fifth special message. Enclosure II provides lists of the proposed rescissions as submitted by the President in his special message.

The figures shown for budgetary resources on the President's impoundment report do not match the corresponding figures shown on the Department of Defense apportionment schedules for these Military Construction accounts. According to OMB, the apportionment statements for these accounts show less total budgetary resources than those reported by the President in his special message because only fiscal year 1996 reimbursements and transfers are reflected on the apportionment statement. The apportionment statements do not reflect reimbursables or carryovers from prior fiscal years. (Military Construction are typically available for 5 years.) OMB confirmed, however, that the President's special message contains prior fiscal year carryovers of budget authority and accurately reflects total budgetary resources in these accounts.
